WHEREAS, the week of October 20-27, 1985, has been proclaimed nationally as American Energy Awareness Week; and

WHEREAS, escalating energy costs continue to have a significant adverse impact on the District's budget, particularly in view of the limited availability of financial resources; and

WHEREAS, energy resources in the world are finite and supplies are dwindling, while demand increases; and

WHEREAS, our nation needs to conserve its natural resources which would promote national security and insure peace and prosperity; and

WHEREAS, the District initiated its Energy Conservation Program in 1976-77 to implement appropriate measures to reduce the use of energy and yet continue to provide an environment conducive to the educational process; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of these energy conservation measures have resulted in significant cost avoidance approximating \$32 million; and

WHEREAS, the concern for and conservation of energy is the responsibility of students, staff and District personnel located at all schools and offices: Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Los Angeles City Board of Education proclaims the week of October 20-27, 1985, as American Energy Awareness Week throughout the District, and urges appropriate activities in all schools and offices to recognize the importance of energy conservation and conduct instructional and other programs to promote energy awareness through energy education.
