WHEREAS the week of October 19-25, 1986, has been proclaimed nationally as American Energy Awareness Week; and

WHEREAS escalating energy costs continue to have a significant adverse impact on the District's budget, particularly in view of the limited availability of financial resources; and

WHEREAS energy resources in the world are finite and supplies are dwindling while demand is increasing; and

WHEREAS our nation needs to conserve its national resources; and

WHEREAS the District initiated its Energy Conservation Program in 1976-77 to implement appropriate measures to reduce the use of energy and yet continue to provide an environment conducive to the educational process; and

WHEREAS the implementation of these energy conservation measures has resulted in significant cost avoidance approximating \$52 million; and

WHEREAS the concern for and conservation of energy is the responsibility of students, staff and personnel located at all District schools and offices: Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED That the Los Angeles City Board of Education proclaim the week of October 19-25, 1986, as American Energy Awareness Week throughout the District, and urge appropriate activities in all schools and offices to recognize the importance of energy conservation and conduct instructional and other programs to promote energy awareness through energy education.
