MOTION RESOLUTION

Whereas, April 15, 1991, has been proclaimed as National Recycle Day and the week of April 15-21, 1991, as California Recycle Week;

Whereas, Teaching our young students the importance of protecting the environment will lead to their acceptance and participation in projects and programs to protect the environment;

Whereas, The Los Angeles Unified School District recognizes its obligations as a public educational institution to set an example for its students and the community by implementing programs to reduce, reuse and recycle waste materials;

Whereas, The District has implemented its Master Plan for Recycling that includes the recycling of cardboard, wood waste, motor oil, wooden pallets, automotive batteries, vehicle tires, and provides unclaimed meals to the needy;

Whereas, The District has also inaugurated a Paper Recycling Program and a nationally-recognized, first-of-its-kind Styrofoam Recycling Program, that together avoid sending over 100 tons of waste per week to landfills at a savings in dumping fees of over \$3,500 per week and rebates the monies generated from the sale of these materials to the schools; and

Whereas, The District will continue to pursue the recycling of other materials to reduce the burden on our waste stream and to establish guidelines for the purchase of products manufactured using recycled materials; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles proclaim April 15, 1991, as National Recycle Day and the week of April 15-21, 1991, as California Recycle Week; and be it

Resolved further, That the Board of Education encourage students through its educational system to continue to preserve and protect our environment through recycling.
