MOTION RESOLUTION

Whereas, The month of October 1990 has been proclaimed nationally as Energy Awareness Month, and the theme for this year's campaign is, "Energy: Plan It for the Planet";

Whereas, Energy resources in the world are finite and supplies are not assured;

Whereas, This is a year of international energy crisis, and our nation needs to conserve its national resources to thereby contribute to its energy independence;

Whereas, The District recognizes the importance of energy management as it relates to economic prosperity and national security;

Whereas, The education of young people in the area of energy is vital to the future of this nation;

Whereas, Rising energy costs continue to have a significant impact on the District's budget, particularly in view of the limited availability of financial resources;

Whereas, The District initiated its Energy Conservation Program in 1976-77 to implement appropriate measures to reduce the use of energy and yet continue to provide an environment conducive to the educational process;

Whereas, The implementation of these energy conservation measures has resulted in significant cost avoidance approximating \$127 million; and

Whereas, The concern for, and conservation of energy is the responsibility of students, staff and personnel located at all District schools and offices; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles proclaim the month of October 1990 as Energy Awareness Month throughout the District, urge appropriate activities in all schools and offices to recognize the importance of energy conservation and energy efficiency, and conduct instructional and other programs to promote energy awareness.
